Luke’s Gospel gives several details of resurrection Sunday:

What they found:

1. The stone was rolled away
2. The body was missing
3. “He is not here He is risen”

What they remembered:

1. Jesus told them about this when he was in Galilee
2. He told them he would be put to death
3. He told them how He would rise on the third day

What they Reported:

1. They reported what they saw and what they heard
2. The disciples questioned their story
3. Peter went to investigate

Fast Forward several hours on the road to Emmaus:

The encounter with Jesus reveals three things about these men:

I. We learn about their despair

1. Their hope was shattered
2. Their faith was shattered
3. Their information was incomplete

II. We learn about their discovery

1. What did they know?            They knew a lot
2. What did they not know?       How it all fit together
3. What did they need to know?   Jesus is alive!

III. We learn about their declaration

They could not keep silent about:

1. What they learned
2. What they heard
3. What they saw
4. What they knew

Their eyes were opened, their hearts were burning, their lives were changed and they could not keep silent!
